Dana passed away from complications of his Parkinson's on Wednesday, November 9 with all of our children present.

Memorial Service will be on December 3, at 2:00 pm. Lemon Grove United Methodist Church. 3205 Washington Street, Lemon Grove. (plenty of parking there!).

Please, no flowers, contributions can be sent to the Parkinson's Foundation.

Interment will be this summer in New York, in the same cemetery that his parents,

grandparents and other relatives are buried.

He developed breathing problems, and could not swallow, and developed pneumonia

He went to the VA Hospital in La Jolla on October 29. They took great care of him. After he passed, the Palliative Care Unit performed a simple 'hale and farewell' ceremony, with the body covered with the American Flag.

Since then, I have been attempting to assess Dana's impact on our activity -- and on our club in particular. His impact is so great, that it is hard to measure. Dana and Lynn have been members of the Spinners from the very beginning of the club. From my recollection, the only meeting they missed was the one where the charter members were identified. That's the only reason why they are not listed officially as charter members. Personally, I think they are as close to being charter members as they come and they should be given that designation anyway. What do you think?

Speaking just to Dana's life in square dancing, there are countless hours of service on all levels -- from the club level, SDSDA, and the State Council. Dana and Lynn served as presidents of the SDSDA for two years. Dana served as president of our

club for over 20 years, 17 of which were in consecutive terms. Twenty years, that's something in itself! Dana has a steady and calm leadership style. He was not rattled by much. While some questioned Dana's opinions on some topics, no one questioned his good intentions for our club and the activity. He has certainly helped me out greatly over the years -- from supporting me to be the club caller for the Spinners, to encouraging me to stay when I felt like quitting. His steady leadership has kept the club going through good times and lean times.

There is more to be said, but that may wait until later -- many stories, many situations. Perhaps not enough can be said. Our thoughts and prayers go out to Lynn and the rest of their family, many of whom have been

Spinners in the past. I hope to see everyone at Dana's memorial service which, I am sure, is announced elsewhere in this newsletter.
